Background Information	Proposed Itinerary
<p>Saint Paul Catholic Church is pleased to offer another trip to the Saint Paul Clinic in El Rosario, Honduras.</p> <p>After Hurricane Mitch in 1998, in response to the medical needs of the poor of El Rosario, Saint Paul Church helped establish a medical clinic in El Rosario Honduras. Saint Paul church now supports the clinic with a yearly grant and sends two delegations annually for medical and organizational support.</p> <p>In addition to assisting the clinic there will be an opportunity to observe other medical projects as well as the Hospital Esculca. The largest public Hospital in Honduras.</p> <p>We ask our parishioners, friends and the medical community to seriously and prayerfully consider joining (all or part of) this trip. Participants should commit to being flexible and open to the rich experience this trip has to offer.</p> <p>This is a tentative schedule and will depend on the number of medical professionals attending and their specialties. Other work sites and tours can be arranged.
